

Greater Manchester Personalised Care ARRS role support:

Learning events

As part of a Greater Manchester Social Prescribing Network, there are 4-8 learning events a year, developed in direct response to training needs expressed by Social Prescribing Link Workers, Health and Wellbeing Coaches and Care Coordinators.

Examples of previous learning; Long Term Health Condition training, Mental Health, Living Life To The Full approach and worksheets, Health Coaching, welfare and financial support.

Peer support network (role specific)

An informal session, where you can meet others who are carrying out the same role as you, to network, share good practice, as well as getting ideas to overcome challenges. Charlotte Leonhardsen, Greater Manchester Social Prescribing Lead provides support for the 3 Personalised Care ARRS roles and will also share updates from both a national and regional perspective.

Action Learning Sets

Action Learning Set sessions will be based around sharing initial challenges or problems, leading to peer-to-peer support and problem-solving. These sessions are open to all Link Workers, Care Coordinators, and Health and Wellbeing Coaches in Greater Manchester – irrespective of where and how you are employed. They will run alongside the sessions detailed above. The sessions are facilitated by Alan and Rowan, Occupational Therapists specialised in mental health, from the University of Salford
