

Clinical lead / mentor role for the Community Pharmacy Independent Prescriber Pathfinder Programme

The Community Pharmacy Independent Prescriber Pathfinder Programme is a nationally funded programme which aims to establish a framework for the future commissioning of NHS community pharmacy clinical services incorporating independent prescribing for patients in primary care.

Community pharmacy independent prescribers have been in place for several years, but have not, to date, been commissioned to deliver NHS services, and so have been supporting patients with prescribing on a private basis. This NHS England pathfinder programme recognises that harnessing the skills and workforce capabilities of pharmacist prescribers, and enhancing pharmacy technician roles would expand capacity within primary care for patients needing access to prescription only treatments.

In NHS GM, we have 10 pathfinder sites, and 25+ community pharmacy independent prescribers who will be commissioned to run clinics in their community pharmacies for patients with minor illnesses, respiratory conditions, and hypertension. The clinical supervision of the community pharmacy independent prescribers is the responsibility of their employers, and each pathfinder site has a Non-Medical Prescribing (NMP) policy in place to cover these aspects.

We are seeking an ICB Clinical Lead to provide clinical leadership, oversight, support, and consultation to the community pharmacy independent prescribers in the pathfinder programme. The Clinical Lead role will comprise maximum one session per week to 31st March 2025 to support improved quality of patient care through professional practice and reflection, help to develop insights, refine care standards and to increase confidence of the community pharmacy independent prescribers.

This is an exciting opportunity to be part of a ground-breaking pathfinder programme which will be instrumental in shaping the future of community pharmacy services, and the place of community pharmacy within primary care, as well as supporting and improving collaborative working between general practice and community pharmacy; we hope that Non-Medical and Medical Prescribers across Greater Manchester will see the value in this opportunity and apply for the role.
