Our thanks to everyone who has shared their views, we had more than 300 responses to our survey from across all sectors of primary care and it is very much appreciated that you took the time to respond. We have heard you and we are now taking the next steps to put the appropriate channels in place that best match what you told us you'd prefer.

The whole exercise is to streamline the amount of communications sent to primary care so, as you can imagine, this is going to take us a few weeks to sort the logistics of how we do this across Greater Manchester, but we are working on it and hope to have an update for you as soon as possible.

In the meantime, please do bear with us while we continue our legacy communication channels from the localities and GM primary care team. We know they are not ideal, but improvements are on the way.
